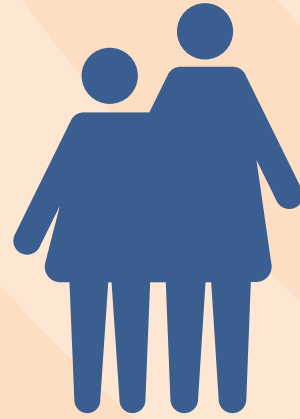


A pathway out of homelessness

A middle-aged sole parenting woman and her 11-year-old daughter moved from New South Wales to Queensland to escape domestic and family violence. After being evicted from their private rental and with nowhere else to go, they ended up sleeping in their car. As a result, they struggled to access health services, and the daughter was unable to attend school.
